

REACH DECLARATION

Registration, Evaluation and Authorisation of Chemicals: directive 1907/2006 EU – 18 Dec 2006 (update 25 June 2025 – REACH 250), List of substances included in Annex XIV of REACH ("Authorisation List") (update 01 November 2023 – 59 entries) and Annex XVII restricted substances (RS)List (update 25 Augustus 2025 – 77 unique substances/entries)

Definition

REACH is a regulation of the European Union, adopted to improve the protection of human health and the environment from the risks that can be posed by chemicals, while enhancing the competitiveness of the EU chemicals industry. This by:

- inventory through a mandatory registration of the producer or importer;
- evaluate in terms of their risks to humans and the environment;
- and to give (authorization) to be used.

Parts purchase.

As a downstream user, Page Electronics NV relies on the accuracy and completeness of REACH-related information provided by its suppliers. Since we are not in a position to independently verify the chemical composition of all supplied products, our REACH compliance is based primarily on the declarations and documentation received from our suppliers.

We expect all suppliers to fully comply with the REACH Regulation (EC No 1907/2006), including all applicable amendments and updates.

Purchase of consumables and the production process.

Page Electronics NV hereby declares that all chemicals used in its production processes comply with the REACH Regulation. This compliance is based on the Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) provided by the manufacturers of the materials we use..

We make every effort to ensure adherence to all applicable REACH requirements. However, we cannot accept liability for any consequences resulting from non-compliance by our suppliers. Should it be established that delivered products do not meet REACH standards, full responsibility for any indemnification lies with the respective supplier.
